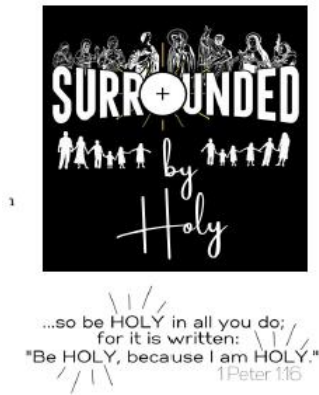

### **October is the Month of the Holy Rosary!**

To help celebrate, the Faith and Family committee has a traveling rosary program to encourage families to participate in this devotion together. Starting this week (October 9th), the classroom teachers will send home rosary packets with the youngest/only in each family. \*Suggested donation of \$5 or more per child.

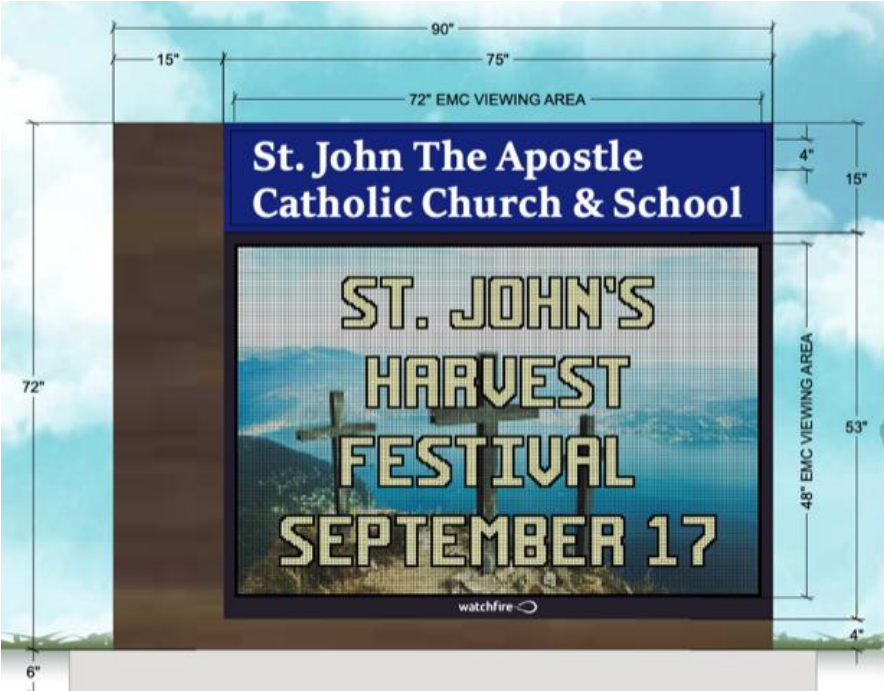
### **Kitchen News**

Clothing is to be **modest** and suitable for recess. If the classroom teacher or office administration deems attire inappropriate, the student will be required to call their parents to bring them a school uniform to change into. Items unacceptable include but not limited to; tight fitting clothing (spandex, leggings, etc...), writing on backsides/bottoms, bottoms shorter than fingertip length, clothing with foul language, inappropriate images, or innuendos, tank tops, spaghetti strap tanks, midriffs, tube tops, or jeans with rips/holes.
