

October is the Month of the Holy Rosary!

Clothing is to be **modest** and suitable for recess. If the classroom teacher or office administration deems attire inappropriate, the student will be required to call their parents to bring them a school uniform to change into. Items unacceptable include but not limited to; tight fitting clothing (spandex, leggings, etc...), writing on backside bottoms, bottoms shorter than fingertip length, clothing with foul language, inappropriate images, or innuendos, tank tops, spaghetti strap tanks, midriffs, tube tops, or jeans with rips/holes.
